How do I sign-in to reserve guest tickets?

Visit https://my.uncc.edu/ and Click on the Athletic Tickets logo under Quick Links or visit www.ticketreturn.com/49ers and sign-in with your NinerNet credentials. *

*Forgot your password? Visit https://ninernet.uncc.edu and select "reset password". Additionally, the IT Service Desk via help@uncc.edu or 704-687-5500 is available to assist.

- Once signed-in, click "Reserve Tickets" beside your commencement ceremony
- Enter Quantity: 3
- Select Ticket Type: \$0.00 Guest Family Reserved
- Choose Ticket Location: Best Seats
- Click Continue
- Click Reserve Tickets
- Enter the Captcha Letters and validate

How many tickets am I able to reserve for commencement?

Students eligible for commencement will be able to reserve 3 tickets for their designated ceremony.

Do I need to reserve a ticket for myself?

No. The only people that will require a printed ticket are your guests. If they do not have a ticket, they will not be permitted to enter Richardson Stadium.

How do I print guest tickets?

After reserving tickets, confirm your tickets by clicking the "Review/Print Your Ticket" link from a laptop or computer or "Your Tickets" link from a mobile device. Your tickets must be printed from a laptop or computer connected to a printer to enter the Jerry Richardson Football Stadium. Mobile tickets will not be accepted. Each ticket has a unique barcode and duplicated tickets will not be valid for admittance.

Where do I park?

Please park in the Student Union parking deck and report to the stadium 90 minutes prior to your ceremony. Graduate entrances are next to gates 4 and 5. You may be dropped off at gate 3. Please bring your UNC Charlotte ID or a picture ID.
